Bus News for 2015-2016

Register your child by May 8, 2015 to ensure a seat on the school bus next fall.

1. If there are no changes to your child's address or school, renew the current registration using the **Returning Student form**. You can renew all your children on the same form.
2. If your child's address or school is changing, complete the **New Student, Change of Address or Change of School form**.



To submit the completed form:

1. Scan and email it to student.transportation@gov.yk.ca
2. Drop it off at the Department of Education, 1000 Lewes Blvd.
3. Fax it to **867-667-8243**.
